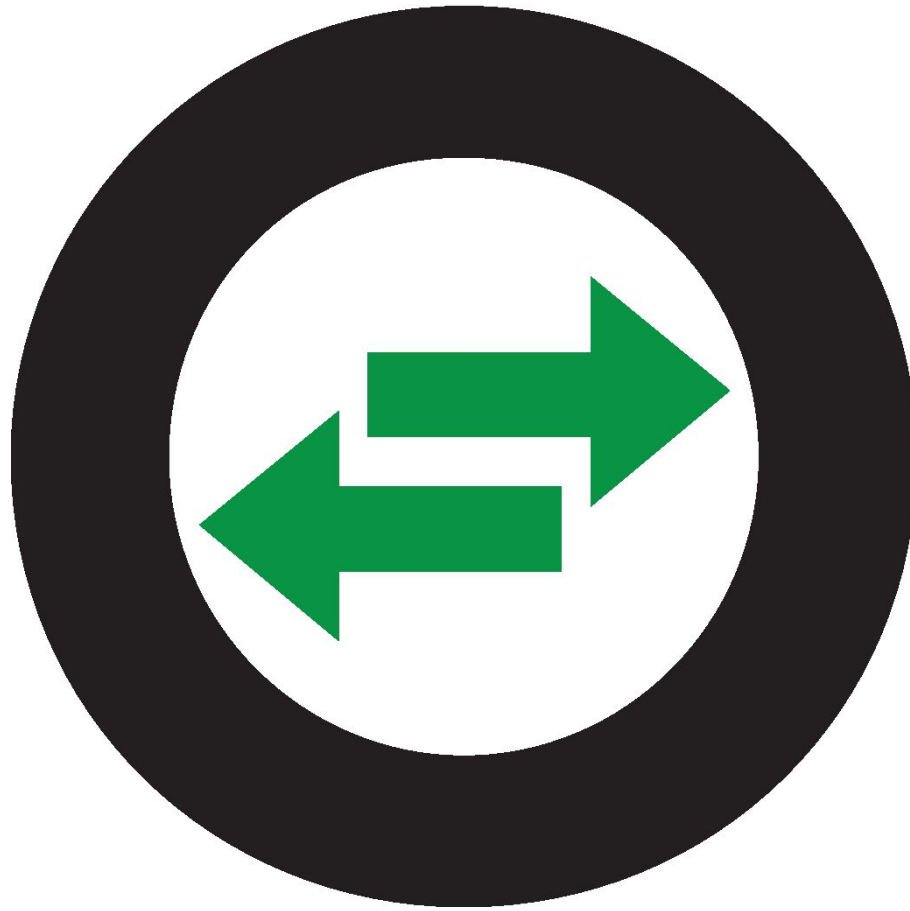

- Open vSwitch Hackathon 2013, Sept. 6-7, in IRC and email
 - ~20 participants
- Open vSwitch Hackathon 2014, March 26-27, at Cisco in San Jose
 - ~50 attendees each day; included many impromptu talks
- Open vSwitch Fall Conference 2014, Nov. 17-18, at VMware in Palo Alto
 - 200 registered attendees + 100 on waitlist
 - 23 talks (30 minutes each)
- Open vSwitch Fall Conference 2015, Nov. 16-17, in San Jose
 - 300 registered attendees + 150 on waitlist
 - About 27 full talks (25 minutes) and 7 lightning talks (5 minutes)
- Open vSwitch Fall Conference 2016, Nov. 7-8, in San Jose
 - ~200 registered attendees
 - \$200 registration fee (previous events were free)
 - About 25 full talks (25 minutes) and 6 lightning talks (5 minutes)
